July 13th

On July 13th we commemorate Saint Dogfan of Wales who was martyred by the heathens in the 5th century. Upon the site of his martyrdom a Church was built under his patronage which still stands to this day.

Verses

On this day we commemorate Saint Mildred of Thanet, one of the three daughters of St Ermenburgh of Minster-in-Thanet in England. She succeeded her mother as Abbess of Thanet. Her relics were enshrined in Canterbury and part of them survive. Her life describes her as 'ever merciful, of easy temper and tranquil'.

On this day we also commemorate Saints Eugene, Salutaris, Muritta and their companions who all martyrs, Saint Julian the first Bishop of Le Mans, and Saint Turiaf the Bishop of Dol in Brittany.
