August 5th

On August 5 we commemoate Saint Afra the Great Martyr of Augsburg. Saint Afra was born into a pagan family, but her search for Truth led her to receive the teachings of the Holy Bishop Narcissus who led her to Christ. Saint Afra and her entire household were baptized and chrismated in the Orthodox faith. When it was discovered Saint Afra and her family had become Christians, they were brought before Emperor Diocletian and ordered to give sacrifice to the pagan gods. Saint Afra refused and was given the crown of martyrdom by fire.
