On December 14th, we commemorate Saint Hybald of Lincolnshire. Saint Hybald was an abbot in Lincolnshire in England. He is remembered as being a virtuous leader of Hibaldstow and his relics still survive in Lincolnshire today.

Verses

On this day we commemorate Saint Venantius Fortunatus. Born near Treviso in the north of Italy, aged thirty he settled in Poitiers in France and was ordained. He became known to Queen St Radegunde who befriended him. He was a writer and poet: the hymns *Vexilla Regis* and *Pange Lingua Gloriosa* were composed by him. He became Bishop of Poitiers at the end of the sixth century.
