

## A Synaxis of Latin Saints (Plain Reading)

June 25th

On June 25<sup>th</sup> we commemorate Saint Maximus of Turin. Saint Maximus was the Bishop of Turin during the barbarian invasions of Northern Italy. During the invasions, he pastored the flock diligently and also wrote numerous homilies, theological tracts and ascetic writings.

### *Verses*

On this day we commemorate Saint Salomon, the King of Brittany. Saint Salomon, like many holy kings before him, was a repentent king who aimed to serve Christ with his throne. He used his authority and strength as king to bring peace to lands that were raged and troubled by rebellious Franks and Norsemen. Upon his assassination, he was commemorated as a martyr by the faithful of Old Rome.

On this day we commemorate Saint Amphibalus, the priest who was sheltered by Saint Alban the Proto-Martyr of Britain. Early in the Christian history of England, Saint Amphibalus was as well known as Saint Alban and traditionally commemorated alongside him.
