

## A Synaxis of Latin Saints (Plain Reading)

October 26th

On October 26th we commemorate Saint Eata of Hexham. A monk at Ripon in England. He later left it for Melrose in Scotland where he became abbot. After the Council of Whitby, he became Abbot of Lindisfarne. In 678 he became Bishop of Lindisfarne and later of Hexham.

### *Verses*

On this day we commemorate Saint Cedd. Saint Cedd was the brother of St Chad of Lichfield, and was a monk at Lindisfarne who enlightened the Midlands of England and later became Bishop of the East Saxons. He founded monasteries in Tilbury and Lastingham.

On this day we commemorate Saint Bean of Scotland. Bishop of Mortlach in Banff in Scotland, he later preached in Aberdeen.

On this day we commemorate Saint Quadregesimus the Subdeacon and shepherd of Policastro in Italy. Miracles were ascribed to him, such as raising a man from the dead.

By the intercessions of Thy Saints, O Christ God, have mercy upon us. Amen.
