

A Synaxis of Latin Saints (Plain Reading)

September 7th

On September 7th we commemorate Saint Clodoaldus, the grandson of King Clovis and Saint Clotilde who became a priest and monk. He founded the monastery of Nogent-sur-Seine, now called Saint-Cloud after him.

Verses

On this day we commemorate Saint Memorius. Saint Memorius was a deacon in Troyes in France with St Luperus, who sent him to the camp of Attila with five companions to ask for mercy. Attila had them all beheaded.

On this day we commemorate Saint Alcmund, the seventh Bishop of Hexham in England. The diocese of Hexham was an extremely troubled region of England where many Holy Bishops defended the Church against invading forces. By the time of the 10th century, the entire diocese was eliminated and had to be rebuilt by a number of married priests and their families who rebuilt the physical and spiritual life of the region. They did so by the prayers and commemorations of the Holy Bishops such as Saint Alcmund.

By the intercessions of Thy Saints, O Christ God, have mercy upon us. Amen.
